Committee Charge as written by the FS:

Responsible for recommending policies on admission and transfer of credits and serving as an **appellate board for individual petitions for variances.**

2001-2001 Undergraduate Catalog Copy:

Transfer of Credit Statement (Pg. 17, Column1, item 3):

3. General transfer credit is awarded for courses in which a grade of “C” or higher has been earned. Course work must be applicable to a baccalaureate degree; credit is not granted for course work that is remedial or technical in nature.

Admissions Section (Pg. 15, Column 2, starting the last paragraph, second sentence):

The Campus Faculty committee on admissions and transfer of credit has sole authority to grant any individual a variance from any University admission or transfer policy if the committee deems it appropriate to do so after considering the individual’s petition. Also, the committee has the final authority in interpreting University admission or transfer policies.
