Admission Requirements: Candidates must have a master's degree and a valid building-level certification plus submit either a GRE score or a School Leadership Licensure Assessment (SLLA) score foradmission. Candidates must have a master's degree. In addition, admission to the Ed.S. in Educational Leadership program requires the following: a completed Educational Leadership program application; résumé or CV; response to a prompted application; statement of purpose; academic writing sample; Leadership Disposition Survey; and two three letters of recommendation (one of which should be from a current or former supervisor). the employer). An interview Interview with the Educational Education Leadership program coordinator may be requested. All other requirements for admission to the Graduate School must also be met. The specialist degree is a cohort based program that begins in the Fall semester; therefore, applications for admission must be completed by April 1st. The <u>early admissions deadline for the following Fall semester cohort is November 1st.</u> Candidates are responsible for meeting the experience and licensure prerequisites in the state in which they intend to apply for a license.
