Additional prerequisites may be prescribed by the program area.

Requirements for the Master's of Education Degree:Candidates for the master's degree in physical education must complete 27 semester hours of graduate work and a thesis or 33 semester hours without a thesis. In addition to the

program requirements listed below, all candidates must successfully complete a written comprehensive exam, which is a capstone project that is part of [PHED 6723](#) Project Implementation and Data Analysis.
