<p>1. Creating a new concentration in Conducting for the Doctor of Musical Arts.</p>	<p>1. Over the years, many music educators and conductors throughout our state have reached out to inquire about a terminal degree program. There is currently no terminal degree in music in the State of Arkansas. Because of this, students with career aspirations in higher education, or who desire to pursue education beyond the master's degree must travel to neighboring states (most frequently Kansas, Missouri, Texas, Oklahoma, and Tennessee) to pursue terminal degrees.</p> <p>It makes sense that the University of Arkansas, as the flagship institution of the State, should take the lead in creating such a program. In August 2021, the Department of Music at the University of Arkansas approved a proposal from the conducting faculty (Dr. Christopher Knighten - Director of Bands and Dr. Jeffrey Allen Murdock -</p>

	<p>Director of Choral Activities) to create a Doctor of Musical Arts degree program at the Fayetteville Campus, housed within the Fulbright College of Arts and Sciences. This move comes with the pressing need to provide an opportunity for the musicians/scholars/conductors of Arkansas, specifically, to obtain the D.M.A. in Conducting, creating the first terminal degree in music in the state.</p> <p>Per ADHE and University protocol, we have notified peer institutions in the state that this process is moving forward.</p>
