	There is currently no terminal degree in music in
	the State of Arkansas. Because of this, students
	with career aspirations in higher education, or
	who desire to pursue education beyond the
	master's degree must travel to neighboring states
	(most frequently Kansas, Missouri, Texas,
	Oklahoma, and Tennessee) to pursue terminal
	degrees.
	It makes sense that the University of Arkansas, as
	the flagship institution of the State, should take
	the lead in creating such a program. In August
	2021, the Department of Music at the University
	of Arkansas approved a proposal from the
	conducting faculty (Dr. Christopher Knighten -
	Director of Bands and Dr. Jeffrey Allen Murdock -
