~~GEOS 3033 Building Materials Field Studies is the required field capstone course that will require two weekends (Saturday and Sunday) for completion. The course has been specifically designed for this program and will discuss the nature of building materials (wood, brick, mortar and stone), their identification and properties, weathering and erosion theory, assessment and mitigation (i.e. cleaning, consolidants, innovative trends). It is suggested that this class be taken last in the program series.~~ One semester participation in the University of Arkansas' Rome Program will substitute for six (6) credits from class requirements in Architectural History and Urban Studies listed above. A supplemental program internship is suggested in addition to the classes required if the student's career path is in Historic Preservation.
