<p>The proposal reduces the total number of required credit hours to align with comparable minors across campus. The change of studio requirement reflects the current practice in the school of offering interdisciplinary Advanced Design Studios in the 4th or 5th year of a student’s curriculum that has significant Interior Design content and is taught or co-taught by Interior Design faculty.</p>	<p>The current Interior Design minor requires 28 total credit hours and is only available to other majors in the Fay Jones School of Architecture and Design. This is significantly greater than most minors offered at University of Arkansas. The current IDES minor degree plan currently requires three studios which are not logical for the student population (Architecture and Landscape Architecture majors).</p>
