<p>The structure of the program coursework was adjusted to include a pre-major (PBHL). No new courses were added.</p> <p>No changes to the degree requirements. The curriculum was restructured. The courses noted in red were either moved around or moved to pre-PBHL page.</p>	<p>The Council on Education for Public Health accredited the B.S. program July of 2019. However, they are requiring an interim report by April 22 that details how we have corrected any noted deficiencies during their program review. One of the deficiencies noted was a failure to comply with Criterion 1.2 which specifies that the program has administrative autonomy regarding admission to the program. CEPH indicated that failure to come into compliance with all accreditation criteria must trigger specific actions on CEPH’s part, which includes revocation of accreditation. Therefore, the program has examined similar programs at comparable institutions and has drafted the included admissions protocol.</p>
