Description of specific change	Justification for this change
Changing the requirement from a 'C' or higher on the paper to a 'C' or higher in the class.	Simplifying the process and making it easier to track and fulfill. A grade of a "C" overall in a course would be a sufficient metric. Faculty will continue to emphasize writing in their courses that fulfill this requirement, so it's really just a change in how we measure completion of this (not what we include to guarantee students practice writing and get feedback on it), with the goal of shifting away from grade on final paper as the metric to the overall course grade.
