Requirements

The Master of Science in Food Safety program requires a total of 30 hours of graduate-level work. Each student will complete one three-hour <u>capstone project</u> special problem in which a technical paper will be developed. <u>However, if a student is interested in a This requirement may be satisfied by an approved</u> thesis <u>track, project in the capstone requirement may be satisfied by an approved thesis project through one Poultry or Food Science department. No</u>

more than a total of the participating departments. No more than 6 credit hours of thesis, special problems, problems and internships may be are recognized for degree requirements. requirements with no more than a total of 6 hours of special problems and internships. Each special problem course should be limited to three hours of credit. An oral examination covering over all coursework course work and the capstone special problem project or thesis is required.

The student's advisory committee will outline the total program of study and will also determine if any course deficiencies should be addressed. An applicant must meet all of the requirements for admission to the Graduate School. The program's steering committee provides guidelines for student admission and establishes degree requirements. The student and the Program Coordinator, with approval of the Dean of the Graduate School, select a major adviser. The major adviser, in consultation with the student, will recommend additional faculty members to serve on the student's advisory committee. committee, including one member from the program steering committee.

Students should also be aware of Graduate School requirements with regard to master's degrees.
