Admission Requirements: Candidates must have a master's degree **and in educational leadership plus submit either a valid building-level certification plus submit either GRE score or a GRE score or a School Leadership Licensure Assessment (SLLA) score for admission. In addition, admission to Ed.S. in Educational Leadership requires the following: a completed Educational Leadership program application; statement All other requirements of purpose; academic writing sample; Leadership Disposition Survey; admission to the graduate school and three letters of recommendation (one of which should Educational Leadership program must also be from the employer). met. Interview with the EDLE program coordinator may be requested. All other requirements for admission to the Graduate School must also be met.**

Requirements for the Educational Specialist Degree (30 hours post Masters): The specialist degree program in Educational Leadership is designed primarily to provide professional preparation for students involved in school-site administration and those individuals who have districtwide administrative responsibilities.
