Requirements

<u>Application</u> Prerequisites to M.P.H. Degree Program: The Public Health program undertakes a holistic review of applicants. For acceptance to the program, the student must meet the general requirements for admission to the Graduate School, have earned an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution, and meet the following admission standards: a 3.00 GPA on the last 60 hours of undergraduate course work (excluding student teaching). Further, the student will also need to submit a resume/curriculum vitae and 500-word interest statement to be considered for program admission.

Additional Requirements for International Applicants:

For international medical school graduates, <u>United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE)</u> USMLE Steps 1 and 2 (both parts) are required. Foreign medical graduates must also submit an earned <u>Education Commission for</u> <u>Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certificate (will</u> ECFMG certificate. (Will be used in lieu of GRE).

World Education Services (WES). Any applicant who has completed all or part of their education outside the United States is required to submit a foreign credentials evaluation byWES. <u>Additionally</u>, all applicants must meet Meet the English Language Proficiency Requirements for Admission to the Graduate School as defined in the Graduate <u>Catalog</u>. <u>Catalog</u>

Application to Accelerated Masters of Public Health Degree Program:

<u>Applicants for the Master of Public Health (MPH) under the Accelerated Masters path must be a University of</u> <u>Arkansas undergraduate student pursuing a bachelor's degree in Public Health (Pre-PBHLBS or PBHLBS), and must</u> <u>have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 when applying.</u> <u>Applications are due fall of the student's Junior year (i.e., 5th</u> <u>semester) or during the semester in which they will complete at least 75 hours of coursework.</u> <u>Specific deadlines</u> <u>are posted on the website:https://publichealth.uark.edu/mph.</u>

Entry to the program allows students to take MPH classes as an undergraduate student (see below).

Admission is competitive and all prospective students who apply through the accelerated masters program are evaluated by the Public Health Program faculty using a variety of factors including GPA and resume/curriculum vitae. GRE Scores are not required to apply to MPH program through the accelerated masters path.

Courses Completed during the Final 3 Academic Semesters:

Accelerated Masters students may take up to 15 hours of graduate coursework (5000 and 6000 level coursework) in the last three academic regular semesters (fall and spring) of their undergraduate degree that will be counted toward both the B.S. and MPH degrees. The required courses and timing of completion are PBHL 5563 [in lieu of PBHL 3643 (spring junior year)], NURS 5063 and PBHL 5533 [in lieu of PBHL 3202 and PBHL 4603, respectively (fall senior year)], and PBHL 5613 and PBHL 574V [in lieu of PBHL 4613 and PBHL 4043, respectively (Spring senior year)]. Upon completion of the B.S. degree (including the graduate courses), the accelerated masters students who have at least an average 3.0 GPA in PBHL graduate courses will be accepted by the program faculty into the PBHL MPH degree program after admittance into the Graduate School.

<u>Requirements for the Master of Public Health Degree:</u> Candidates for the MPH degree must complete 24 semester hours of required core courses, 12 hours of concentration courses, and 6 hours of capstone, for a total of 42 credit hours. A graduate GPA of 3.0 or better is required for graduation. In addition, all degree candidates must successfully complete the capstone project.

Students should also be aware of Graduate School requirements with regard to master's degrees.
