All EDLE students in the PSDLMC program are required to complete course significant activities with matching rubrics to meet required ELCC SPA standards for CAEP accreditation. These are identified in each course syllabus. An intensive 6 month internship under district-level administrator/mentor is required. To be licensed by the Arkansas Department of Education as a district-level administrator, the student must successfully complete a culminating portfolio defense demonstrating their readiness for district-level leadership before a portfolio committee comprised of three EDLE faculty and one licensed district-level practicing administrators prior to taking the National School Superintendent Assessment (SSA).
