To create foundational programming for the new center, we will combine all programs from the Center for Learning and Student Success, the Office of Student Success, and University Perspectives. This comprehensive approach strives to ensure that every student who attends the U of A can be successful. The center is designed to provide assistance to all students in meeting their unique academic goals. Thousands of students participate in our programming each year: Tutoring in a variety of subjects (math, the sciences, world languages, business, economics, and other courses taught throughout the university); Writing Support; Supplemental Instruction in the sciences, economics, accounting, and data analysis; Academic Coaching; University Perspectives; 360 Advising; Effective College Learning; Persistence Scholarships; Peer Mentoring; Accelerate Student Achievement Program (ASAP); Self-help resources dealing with study skills, time management, test taking, anxiety reduction, and effective learning strategies; The center's primary locations are in the Garland Center and Gregson Hall. The majority of SI, tutoring and writing support is available from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays, and from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Fridays. Tutoring is also available on Sunday afternoons in the Multicultural Center (Arkansas Union) and Mullins Library. The center partners with the colleges, Student Affairs, University Housing, Mullins Library, and the Multicultural Center to provide unique tutoring and other assistance to students in a variety of locations and formats.
