<p>CATE 3003 Teaching Housing and Interior Design to Secondary Students replaced CATE 4803 Special Problems: Housing. This class was redesigned to meet student needs for better alignment with the PRAXIS Family and Consumer Sciences Education core assessment. CATE 4803: Teaching Apparel Production to Secondary students is being proposed to replace AMPD 1023 Introduction to Apparel Production. This will better align with what is being taught in public schools and will allow students experience with teaching apparel production prior to student teaching.</p>	<p>To better align the overall academic program with the three concentrations. Curriculum courses were redesigned to better align with the PRAXIS Family and Consumer Sciences core assessment.</p>
