Removed CIED 3103 and CIED 3113	Program faculty believe that the course focusing on Dyslexia is more appropriate for students in the Special Education major.
Added SPED 4173 Introduction to Dyslexia (course in CIM for approval)	to replace literacy content due to removal of CIED 3103 & CIED 3113
Increased elective hours by 3 to maintain 120 for degree completion	due to removal of 6 hours literacy but replaced only 3 with new SPED course
